PVEN Food Pantry is again offering our annual Angel Tree Program, with the assistance of the Monroe County Marine Corps Toys For Tots program, to qualifying families with children in our community.

Who can participate?

- Families with children ages newborn- 17 who reside within the Monroe County townships of Chestnuthill, Eldred, Hamilton, Jackson, Polk and Ross.
- Families must meet the financial guidelines established by the PA Dept. of Agriculture's Bureau of Food Distribution The Emergency Food Assistance Program (guidelines are at www.pven.net under Services)

Required Documentation to register:

1. Birth Certificates for all children 17 and under and custody papers, if applicable.
2. Current documents for 2017 verifying income for the ENTIRE household. (Income tax records from 2016 will not be accepted.) This includes, but is not limited to
 - public assistance records stating amounts received,
 - disability benefits/ SSI/ Social Security for 2017
 - Pensions
 - Child Support
 - Unemployment benefits
 - Pay stubs (4 if paid weekly, 2 if paid bi-weekly)
3. Verification of address by lease, mortgage, or property taxes must have the year 2017 on the documents. Rent receipts/bills will NOT be accepted.
4. All addresses must be a physical address and not a PO Box

Angel Tree Information needed at time of registration is as follows:

- Clothing sizes (including shoes and boots) and information as specific as possible. (Example: girl's 12 slim, men's pants 29x32, junior 3, women's 22, color, brand, sports team, if applicable)
- Two wishes for each child not to exceed \$50 each (retail price). The wishes are used as a guideline, not as a guarantee. The Angel Tree program is sponsored by the surrounding community.

NOTE: *The Angel Tree program will not supply cell phones, expensive electronic gifts, or gift cards.*

Please note: For Christmas 2017 if you register for toys with any other organization or food pantry, you will NOT be eligible to receive toys through PVEN. An attempt to use multiple organizations for gifts puts you at risk for losing current and future gifts.
